Careful Handling of Laundry

- Use warm water settings to wash clothing, bedding, towels, etc.
- Immediately wash clothing or bedding with blood, stool, or other bodily fluids
- Clean and disinfect clothes hampers after each wash
- Make sure to thoroughly dry laundered items

Mindful Trash Disposal

- Line each trash bin around the home
- Place disposable gloves, facemasks, and other one-time use protective gear in the trash after every use
- Dispose of them regularly, along with household trash, and wash hands immediately afterwards

Cleaning and Disinfecting High-touch Surfaces

- Clean high-touch surfaces, such as tabletops, doorknobs, light switches, bathroom fixtures, counters, toilets, and bedside tables, often
- Use the appropriate disinfectants and carefully follow instructions on their labels to ensure their efficacy
- Pay special attention to cleaning surfaces that might have blood, stool and other body fluids
- Immediately wash hands after home cleaning

Avoid Sharing Tableware

- Have designated dishes, cups, and silverware for each individual. Avoid using another's tableware
- Immediately after use, wash tableware with dish soap and hot water or in the dishwasher
